We are currently seeking a person or volunteers who can serve the church and assist the pastor in the church office. We are considering a variety of options to fill this need:

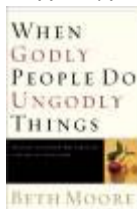
- *16-20 hrs. a week w/hourly pay or Volunteers
